

Introduction

An innovative concept of video-congress!

The aim of this congress is to discuss about surgical techniques for the management of pelvic floor diseases trying to define the surgical procedures learning from the experts' tips and tricks. All the speakers will discuss videos focusing on surgical steps and also present surgical indications with their own results compared to the literature.

This innovative concept of video-congress will wear and informal suit. In fact, each topic will last 25 minutes, 10 min for speaker's presentation and 15 for the discussion, leaving time to get an active engagement from the audience which is also allowed to ask questions during the session.

The discussants will be chosen among all the registered attendees who will agree to play this role, whereby it is not just a discussion between experts, but there will be interactive lectures to answer questions and analyze doubts of the attending scientific community.

At the end of the congress there will be the survey "Let's find an agreement!" based upon 10 statements about the surgical techniques for the treatment of pelvic floor diseases. It will be possible to revise the statement and re-vote them up to 3 rounds in order to achieve a >70% agreement. The final report of the survey could be published and all participants will be considered as co-authors of the collaborative paper.
